2 About the role: Research and Learning Systems Lead

Wasafiri was founded to make good change happen. We believe generating new forms of knowledge and catalysing high-quality learning processes are essential in bringing about systemic change because they connect people and improve flows of information more equitably.

- Are you a proactive, experienced and outgoing person who can develop Wasafiri's research, learning, monitoring and evaluation service?
- Are you an experienced researcher or monitoring, learning and evaluation (MLE) specialist who can work with diverse clients and partners to design methodologies, lead international teams of researchers / MLE staff, and provide clear analysis and action orientated recommendations?

If so, this role may be for you.

The role provides the opportunity to lead research and MLE in thematic areas such as peace/stabilisation, inclusion, food, climate and nature working with governments, implementing organisations and businesses, leading philanthropic and bilateral funders, African and global organisations, and knowledge partners.

Systemcraft is an applied systems change approach that Wasafiri has developed that leaders and organisations value greatly in achieving change. In this role you will be part of the team applying Systemcraft to research / MLE project design and implementation. You will also develop the approach as it relates to measuring systems change, thereby helping shape global best practice.

You will be capable of delivering high quality research / MLE processes and written products. You will have a track record securing funded research or MLE opportunities with clients and partners. You will contribute towards our world leading systems change practice and provide thought leadership externally. You will also strengthen our network of research / MLE consultants and partners.

The role description is provided below.

Research / MLE project leadership and technical implementation (circa 60-70%)

We anticipate you leading and implementing projects. Every Wasafiri project is led by a Team Leader and overseen by a Project Director. You will primarily serve as a hands-on Team Leader or a Project Director for relevant projects. You will also provide technical support on projects led by others. Key responsibilities in the role includes:

- **Project leadership:** Provide high quality team leadership, ensuring our contributions are best placed to effect meaningful change and respond to the client's needs.
- **Technical direction and quality assurance:** Provide research / MLE technical direction and coaching to project teams, supporting all technical aspects of project delivery.
- **Strong client and institutional management:** Engage with clients and their partners, ensuring a strong relationship and institutional engagement for high quality project design and implementation.
- **People and performance management:** Establish and support a project team comprising a mix of staff, and consultant specialists. Successful project delivery depends upon ensuring strong performance and relationship management at the heart of each team.

Research / MLE design and practice development (circa 30-40%)

We wish to expand our support to organisations tackling complex problems, and the role has an important focus on:



- **Designing research and MLE approaches:** These responsibilities are likely to include working with clients to design projects; leading technical design in proposals; establishing a high-quality delivery team; developing the financial structure for a successful project; and writing and presenting proposals.
- **Business development:** Based on Wasafiri strategic approach, build relationships that can create new business development opportunities that advance research and/or MLE. This includes seeking new opportunities in relevant thematic areas, building on our and your track record.
- **Deepening our practice:** The role will strengthen Wasafiri's technical capacity in the application of Systemcraft, particularly as it relates to research and learning, and the capacity across the business to articulate an offer to clients and follow through into implementation.

You will demonstrate a track record with essential skills and experience comprising:

- Applied experience in designing and implementing research and MLE methodologies over 10+ years. We are particularly interested in application to complex problems and adaptive management.
- Ability to analyse complex information and write well in English at pace.
- Innovative collaboration experience including cross-sector and public-private collaboration with good networking capabilities.
- Proven team and people management skills, including for research / knowledge related teams.
- Proven business development track record with diverse clients / funders, including positive engagement that can shape their ideas in a co-creative manner.
- Excellent project management experience.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
- Values that align with those of Wasafiri.

- Consulting experience.
- Work experience in Africa and globally.
- Language skills, notably French and Swahili.
- Thematic experience in one or more areas (notably food, climate, nature, peace, inclusion).

4 Role details

- **Salary:** The position comes with an attractive compensation package dependent on skills and experience in the range of GBP 60,000 65,000 per annum dependent on experience.
- Length: Permanent, full-time. (80% FTE possible)
- Location: Preference will be provided to applicants who can live and work within a daily commute of a Wasafiri office. (Other locations may be considered for exceptional candidates.) Wasafiri has offices in Nairobi, Kenya; and Brighton, UK.



- **Benefits:** If based in Kenya, our standard company-wide international health insurance plan retirement benefits and communication stipend apply.
- **Paid leave:** Each full-time employee works 225 days. Depending on the year, this usually equates to 36 days annual leave including bank holidays (pro-rata for part-time).


